Narcotics Evidence	 Controlled buy or undercover buy and no prosecution – 1 year and 1 day CDS submitted to Forensic Lab, no connection to anyone or Found Property – 1 year and 1 day County Prosecutor or Director of Division of Criminal Justice may authorize use of CDS samples for training K-9s
Firearms Evidence	 Prior to destruction, all necessary tracing tests and IBIS submissions must have been completed Could be returned to owner if not a defendant and can legally possess it Not connected to any suspect/defendant, found property, no prosecution, unable to trace owner – 1 year and 1 day

The **County Prosecutor** or the **Director of the Division of Criminal Justice** may authorize the use of property, otherwise meeting the criteria for destruction, for law enforcement educational purpose or for preservation as a historical object.
